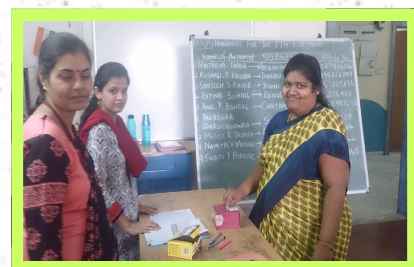

वाहनही : येथील सिटी इंटर स्कूल विद्यार्थ्यांच्या सुरक्षिततेसाठी शाळा प्रशासनाने विविध उपाययोजना हाती घेतल्या असून, कोणताही हलगर्जीगता वाहतूक व्यवस्थेमध्ये होऊ नये, यासाठी महत्तीस येथील वेगळी कल्पना आली आहे. चालकांच्या याचा प्रतिसाद मिळत आहे.

वाहनही येथील सिटी इंटर नॅशनल स्कूल शहराच्या कडकोपच्यातील सुमारे एक हजार विद्यार्थी येतात. त्यातील ४०० विद्यार्थी बसचा लाभ घेतात. शाळेमध्ये १५ बस व तीन छोटीया स्कूल बस आहेत. त्या सर्व आरटीओ नियमांमध्ये बसविण्यात आल्या असून, यापैकी जीटीआरएस ही येथील वापरासाठी बसविण्यात आली आहे. आरटीओ नियमांमध्ये वाहक, चालक आणि यादीचा मालक यांच्या संबंधी करारामे बसविण्यात आले आहेत. यापैकी येथील वाहकाकडून चालक वाहकाची परीक्षा घेण्यासाठी प्रमाणन घेण्यात आले असून, आरोग्य प्रमाणन, चालकाचे निवास

प्रमाणन, कामाच्या अनुषंगाने दाखला, छायाचित्र अशी कागदपत्रे घेण्यात आली आहेत. या बसामध्ये महत्तीस येथील आल्या असून, या महत्तीस चालकांच्या नातेवाईक आहेत. चालकांच्या पत्नीला महत्तीस घेण्यात येण्यास शाळा प्रशासनाने परीक्षा घेतली आहे.

आपल्या पाहण्याची वाहतूक व्यवस्था सुरक्षित आहे का, याची पडताळणी करण्यासाठी चालकांनाही बसामध्ये बसण्याची परवानगी देण्यात आली आहे. वाहकांवर चालक व बस चालक, चालक यांची वेगळी वेळक वेळून किलोमीटरप्रमाणे बसणे दर निश्चित करण्यात आले आहेत. मुख्यध्यायक- चालक समितीही नेमण्यात आली असून, यापैकी राजकीय, सामाजिक व येथील प्रशासनातील चटकना सामान्यतः घेण्यात आले आहे. मुख्यध्यायिका विविता खडकर यांनीही चालक, चालक, चालक, महत्तीस, सुरक्षाध्यायक व निवास घेण्यात आली काळजी घेता असल्याचे समधान वाटत आहे, अशी प्रतिक्रिया दिली.

योग दिवस



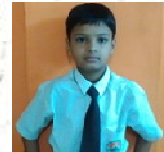
